Pastor's Desk

Receive the Holy Spirit

One of the most important things that has happened in the life of the Catholic Church is its birth through the coming of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles on the day of the Pentecost. The feast of the Pentecost was observed by Jesus and his disciples as it is an Old Covenant observance. It is one of the most ancient feasts in the Church, mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles (20:16). Originally, Pentecost was a Jewish holiday held 50 days after Passover, although the coming of Jesus and his death made the Old Covenant obsolete, yet the Jewish community adhered to it until the temple was destroyed in AD 70.

Even the disciples of Jesus were faithful in their observance. We find them meeting together on Pentecost in AD 31. We are not meeting an Old Covenant requirement nor a New Covenant mandate, as there is no such mandate in the Scriptures. But we observe in our Christian community an anniversary of a very important event in the life of the Church just like we commemorate the celebration of the birth of Jesus and his Resurrection.

Pentecost is when the Apostles went out among the people and began spreading Jesus' message, thus establishing the beginning of the church. With the descent of the Holy Spirit, a New Covenant is inaugurated. Pentecost can be a powerful celebration and a reminder that the Holy Spirit came with power to empower our witness to the Risen Christ. It is the perfect time to remind believers in church that our Heavenly Father will empower our witness.

With the coming of the Holy Spirit the fullness of God is revealed. As the Father is seen in creation and Jesus took our human form and redeemed us, so with the coming of the Holy Spirit the Triune God totally revealed itself by permeating the Holy Spirit to dwell in our midst.

Jesus fulfilled the promise he made to his disciples to wait for the coming of the Spirit. We have been recipient of the gift of the spirit and so it is our bounded duty to be His witnesses to the ends of the world, not just being preachers but proclaimers of His word by our words and deeds. In doing so, he has assured us of His presence in our midst at all times till the end of the world. Let us welcome and congratulate our 2018 Confirmandi as they receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. And let us all march together with the weapon of sanctity to make Him known so that others too can have the spirit of God in them.

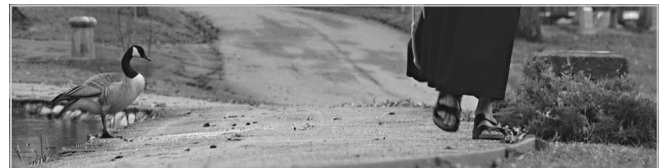

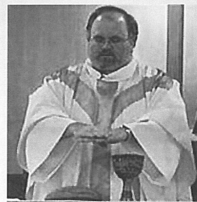
THE JOURNEY OF CAREGIVING

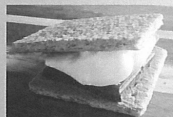

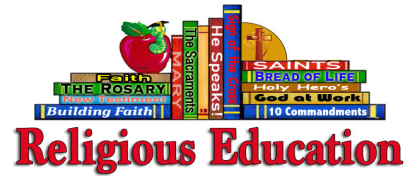

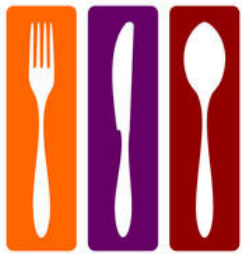
