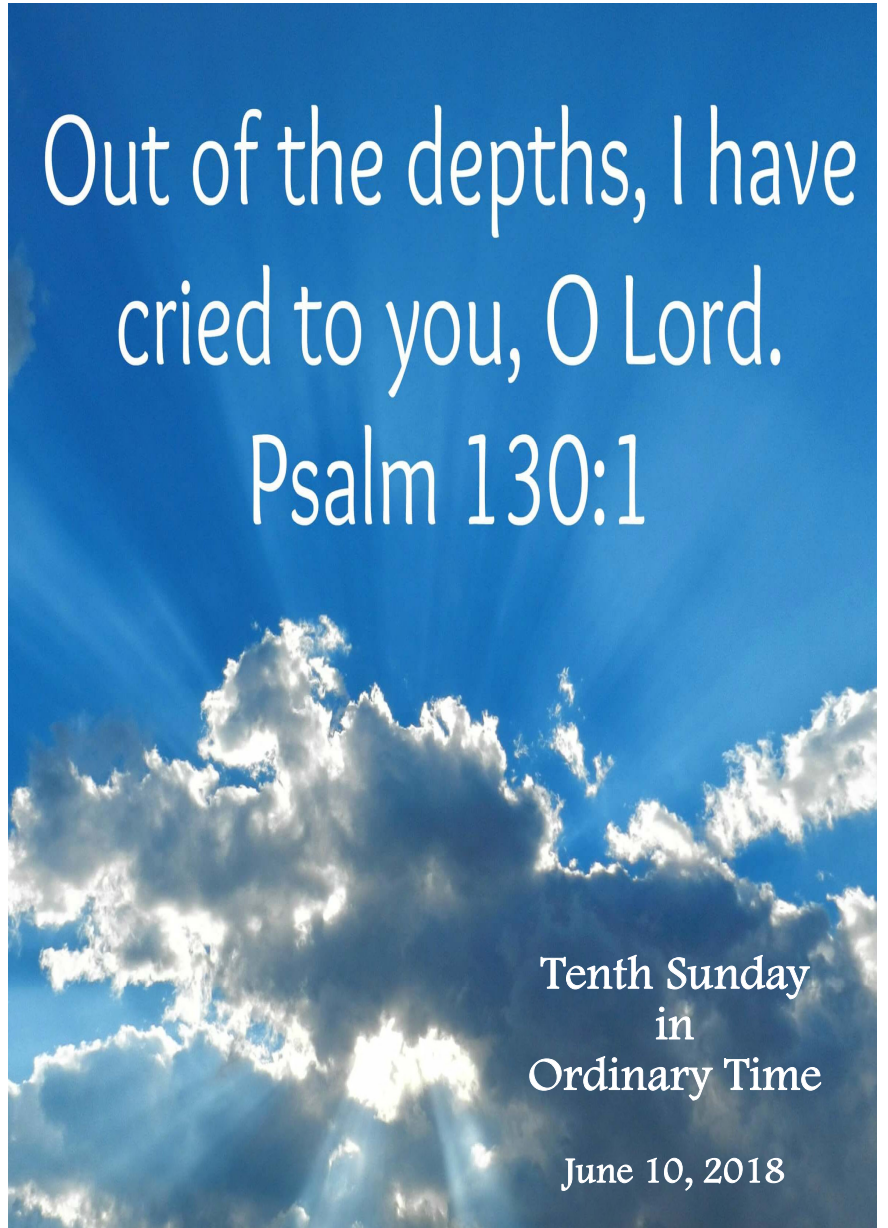

## I CRY TO YOU, O LORD;

The caption of the article "I cry to you, O Lord" is taken from Psalm 130 which is the response to God's word for this weekend liturgy. The suffering and misery that the people of Israel experienced during the exile made them aware of their guilt and stirred in them confidence in God's loving mercy.

Out of desperation or in dire need we will cry out to the Lord in prayer. It is indeed hard for us to admit that we cannot solve a problem or arrive at a solution without the help of God. God delights when we seek Him in all humility of heart that is when he comes to our aid. Crying out to God is an admission of one's need for God. When a situation becomes so desperate, only God can rescue or deliver us. Our cry to the Lord should be one of total unconditional surrender. We should not try to bargain with God but live our life in his hands.

A few passages from the Scriptures will help us understand our need for God and his desire in reaching out to us, when we place our trust and confidence in Him.

- Elijah the prophet of God cried out and God revived a dead child. (1Kings 17:20-22)
- Jehoshaphat cried out, and God delivered him from death. (II Chronicles 18:31)
- Hezekiah cried out and God gave him victory. (II Chronicles 32:20-21)
- Jesus' disciples cried out to Him in a storm, and Jesus calmed the sea. (Luke 8: 23-24)
- Blind Bartimaeus called out to Jesus, and He restored his sight. (Mark 10:46)

The psalmist cries to God from the depth of his need and distress, experiencing great spiritual misery for his sins; whatever they might be. There is an amount of genuineness in his sorrow that his request be heard. At every Eucharist when we gather with a genuine sorrow for our sins and humbly surrender to His will, we will experience peace and joy within our very self. That peace and joy, not only energizes us, but fills us with a sense of confidence in a God who sees to our welfare and wellbeing as a whole.

Let every Eucharistic celebration be an opportunity for us to know more of this God. He is there, waiting for us at all times to come to him with a longing of building a lasting and worthwhile relationship with him. A God for whom all things are possible and without him nothing can be achieved.

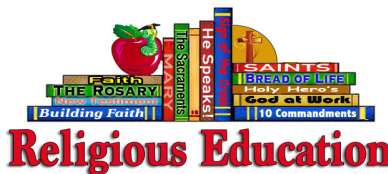


**ALTAR
