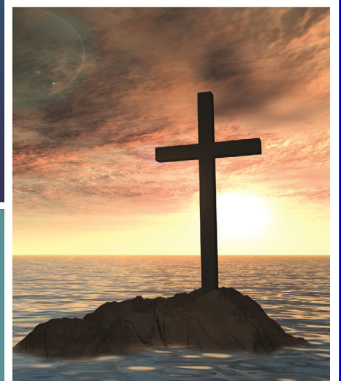

REOPENING IN PHASE 5

As we announced at Masses last weekend and sent out on Flocknote this past Tuesday, here is important information for you to know now that we are in Phase 5 of the State of IL Reopening Plan:

*Reservations are not needed except if we send one out for planning purposes. We again encourage everyone to sign up for our parish communication system, Flocknote, as we will continue to use it to get news out to people. You can sign up to receive an email or a text.

*Weekday Masses are at 8 a.m. M-F. Rosary is prayed beginning at 7:35 a.m. There is currently no 8 a.m. on Saturday. Mass intentions taken for 8 a.m. Saturday will be honored at the 5 p.m. Saturday Mass.

*Weekend Masses are 5 p.m. Saturday and 8 a.m. and 10 a.m. on Sundays.

*Reconciliation is on Saturdays, 11 a.m. to 12 Noon. Enter the door by the stairs and sit in the Chapel. Father will be hearing confessions over by the statue of SJJ.

*Doors to the Church will open ½ hour before each Mass. The two doors you may enter and exit are the one by the stairs and white railings and the one with the long ramp closest to Golf Road. Please do your best to make sure that Father is the last one entering the Mass and the first one leaving from it. The bathroom in the narthex is the only one available and will be sanitized after each Mass (no longer after each person uses it). We will also sanitize the church after each Mass.

*Masks are not required if you are fully vaccinated, but may be worn if you feel more comfortable. **Masks are strongly encouraged for everyone who is not fully vaccinated (adult, teen, or child).** Hand sanitizer will be on the table as you enter if you choose to use it.

*Singing, missalettes, hymnals, and votive lights are back! Holy water fonts and Communion from the cup are not, yet.

*If you are fully vaccinated and would like to bring up the gifts during Mass, please inform one of the work team before Mass begins.

*Once the new collection baskets arrive (with poles) we will resume taking up the collection during Mass. For the next week or so, please place your Sunday and special collection envelopes and donations in the appropriate boxes at the doors of the Church.

*For the next few weeks at least those who are distributing Holy Communion will wear masks but not face shields. They will continue to sanitize their hands before distribution begins.

*Before you leave Mass please lift up the kneeler, return hymnals to the pockets, take your tissues/candy wrappers/etc. with you. Your help and cooperation will make sanitizing move along after Mass.

*Bulletins will continue to go out on Flocknote and be available on the parish website. Paper bulletins will be distributed as you leave Mass if you need a copy.

*Hold in your prayers those members of the parish who cannot or do not feel ready to return to in person worship. We know they are with us in spirit and hold the parish in their prayers as well!

*Thank you and please keep up the good work that allows people to feel welcome, safe, and at home with the Lord and our faith community.

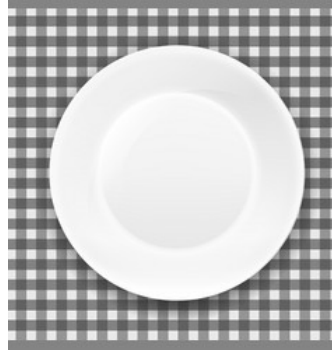
Altar Flowers

Since I am unable now to receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

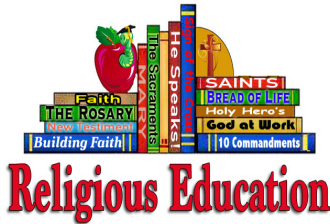
I embrace You as being already there, and unite myself wholly to You.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM REGISTRATION FOR 2021-22

We are looking forward to a great 2021 – 22 Religious Education season! Growing in faith is a lifelong process. Please allow us to help you help your child create a firm foundation in faith and send them each year for religious education! Everyone is welcome! St. Isaac Jogues Church RE Program will be on Mondays, 6:45 – 8:00 p.m., from late August until mid-May, for children in Grs. 1 – Confirmation Year II (Gr. 8 or older) as of September. Kindergarten RE sessions will be on Sundays at 10 a.m. provided at least five (5) students are registered. The current plan for the whole program is to be in person with masks and appropriate distancing. As we move through the summer we will keep you informed of any changes. Please note that students must participate in religious education the immediate two years prior to receiving any sacraments (First Communion, Confirmation)

Registration has begun! If you received forms in the mail, please complete them and mail with a partial payment or drop off in the Rectory mail slot in an envelope to the attention of the RE Office. **If your family will be new** to the RE Program or did not receive forms, please contact the RE Office to arrange for them to be mailed or picked up. Families are also asked to provide a copy of each new child's baptismal certificate (if not baptized here at St. Isaac Jogues) and the dates of any sacraments they have received so far. **Families with children who have special needs and/or older children who have not yet celebrated First Reconciliation or First Communion or are not yet baptized** are encouraged to contact Dolores Stanton to discuss options for learning and preparation, 847/966-1180 or email sjre2004@yahoo.com.

The tuition for parishioners will be as last year: \$200 – 1 child; \$300 – 2 children; \$400 – 3 or more children; book fee is \$40 per student; First Communion/First Reconciliation fee is \$80 and Confirmation Year II fee is \$80. Non-parishioners pay an additional \$100 for tuition but fees remain the same. All are welcome so please call if you need or want to discuss any concerns. Please take care of this important task or registration now so that there is enough time to recruit catechists and assistants as well as order necessary books and materials.

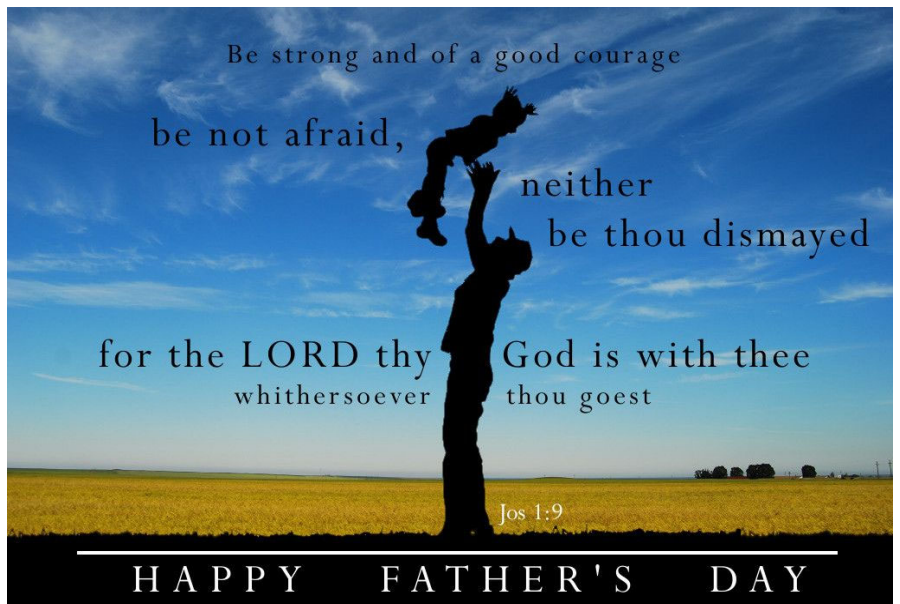

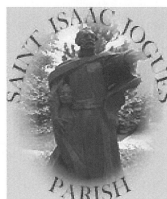
