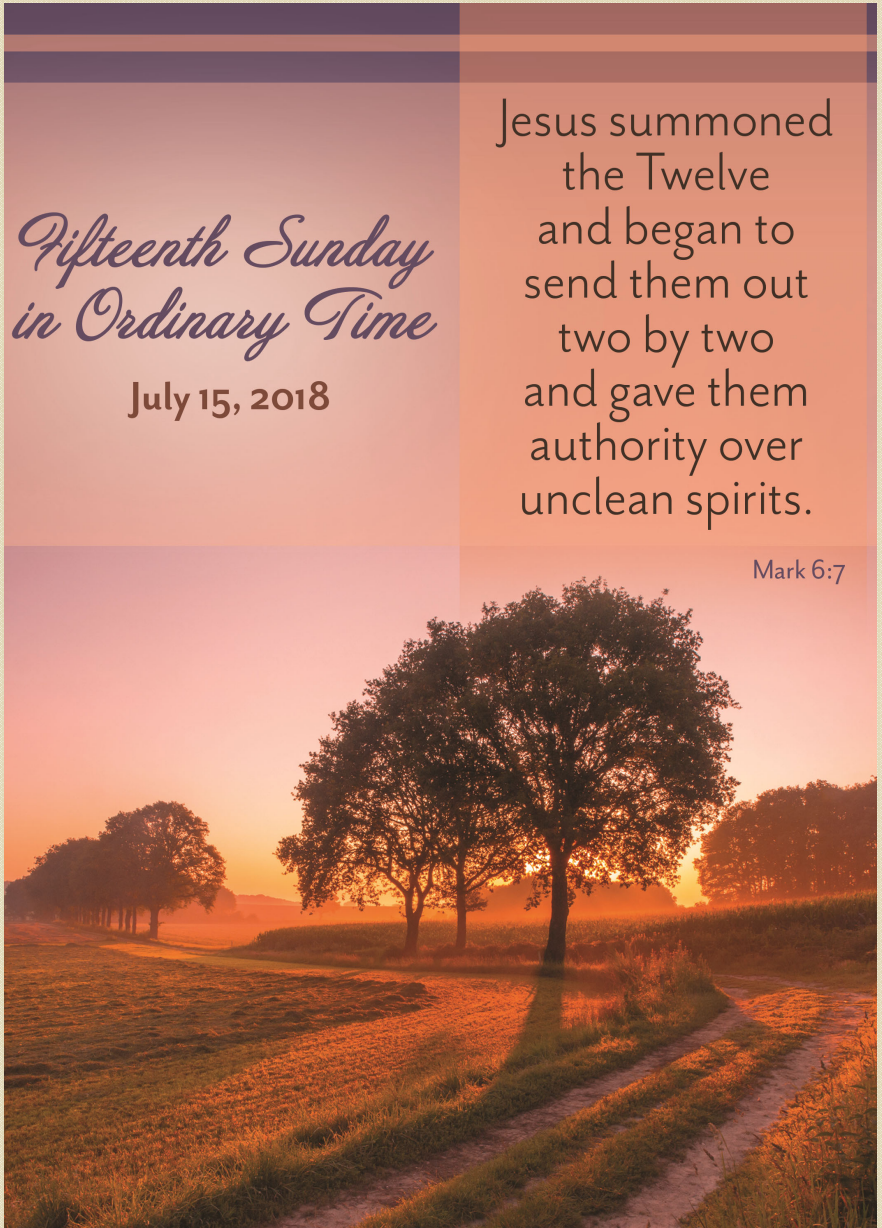

Buddy Concert "A fundraiser for the Parish"

It is also an experience where it helps us bond with a feeling of belongingness towards the parish and its activities. Fundraising activities can determine the future of an organization. A strong fundraising effort can ensure there are adequate funds to support all activities.

The "*Buddy Charles Concert*" has been an activity of the parish for the last ten years. Celebrating our 10th Anniversary performance, we decided to use this event as a Parish fundraising activity. When our intent was conveyed to our performers they were more than willing to help us out. If these performers and their good will are encouraging us with their support, I am sure you would be more than willing to do much more. Every dollar you contribute is so valuable to us and we treasure greatly your support in our venture for the running of the parish.

For leaders of Parish organizations, one of the challenges is ensuring that everyone in the group has some involvement in raising money. For that matter our first step has been establishing a functional fundraising strategy for our upcoming Renovation/Restoration, an extraordinary expense. For that to be successful we designated a Chair & Co-Chair, along with a fundraising committee. It was good to see the willingness of the members present to opt to shoulder the responsibility in the respective groups. We still need more hands to carry out the task that lies ahead of us and as good stewards we try to do our part as best as we can. We all know many hands make work light. If you are willing in any way to help us, we would be more than willing to have you join us.

I express my sincere thanks and appreciation to the performers of the "*Buddy Charles Concert*." They have been marvelous in their performance and generous in their willingness. We hope to see you at the concert on July 15, 2018 at 3.p.m in the Holy Family Room.

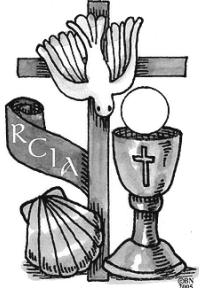
HELPER CATECHIST FOR SPRED

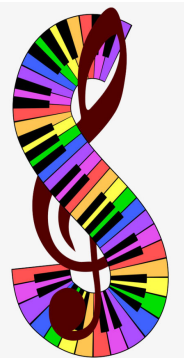

BUDDY CONCERT & DINNER TODAY!

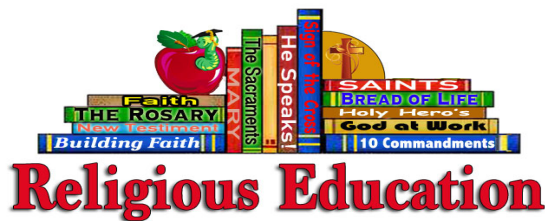

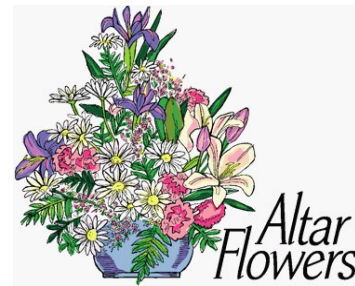


Religious Education
