SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Sacrament of Reconciliation: Saturdays, 11AM - 12:00PM

WHO WAS BUDDY CHARLES GRIES?

Buddy was born in 1927. His mom Ruth played the piano and his stepfather was jazz great, Mugsy Spanier. He had an incredible repertoire and could play thousands of songs from memory. He married Pat in 1954 and they had four children. So he decided it was time to stay closer to home to play gigs because family was always a priority. For over 20 years Buddy played and entertained at The Acorn on Oak, one of Chicago's "in" places for celebrities to visit. Journalist Mike Royko was a big fan of his. When the Acorn closed in 1990, he moved to the Coq D'Or Room in the Drake Hotel. Around 1997 he left there and played in the area and eventually played a few nights a week at Chambers Restaurant in Niles.

At St. Isaac Jogues Church Buddy was a long-time Confirmation Catechist who made sure to teach his students St. Thomas Aquinas' proofs for the existence of God. He was also a Lector and, having a great devotion to our Blessed Mother, led the Rosary offering beautiful reflections that prompted some people to bring tape recorders to listen to them again.

Buddy fought with leukemia the last couple years of his life. In the words of Scott Urban, the tribute's organizer until his death this year, "Buddy Charles was, quite simply, the best entertainer I ever saw. He wasn't the best piano player, although he played brilliantly, He wasn't the greatest singer, though he had a strong, upper baritone, lower tenor voice that was incredibly flexible. But when he blended his skills as a storyteller with his musical talents, it was magical."

The annual tribute started out as what we thought would be a one-time event, because at Buddy's funeral some of his friends heard Father say that his one regret was that he never got to see Buddy perform. Buddy had hoped to do a show to benefit the parish but his illness prevented that from happening. So some of his friends came and gave the show as a gift to the parish in Buddy's memory. Our friendship with them, our gratitude to them, and the tribute show has continued ever since. And before he died he spoke with the Burnells and handed the tribute baton to them so that the tribute goes on...

SCAPULARS OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

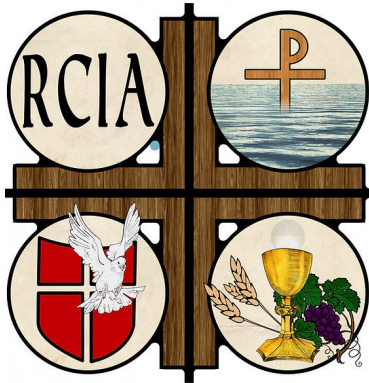
