FOOD DISTRIBUTION WEDNESDAY

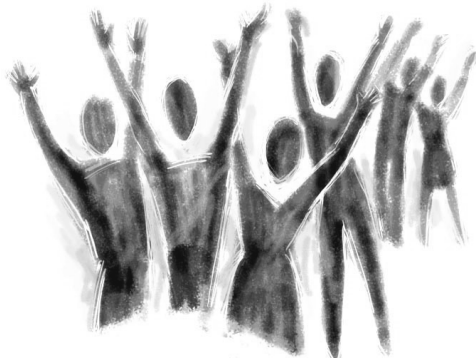

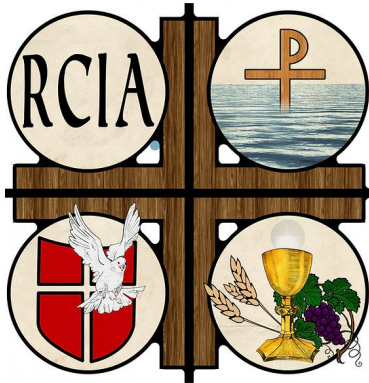
