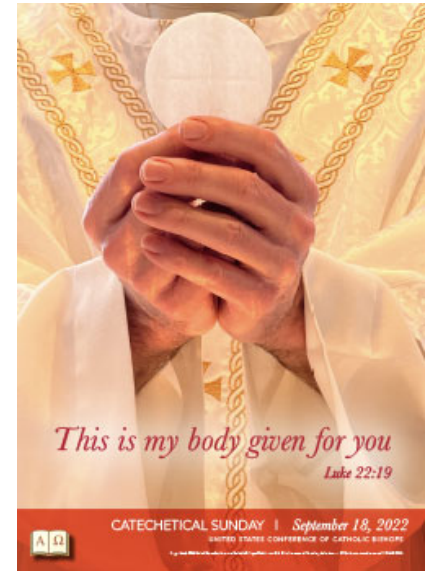




resound?

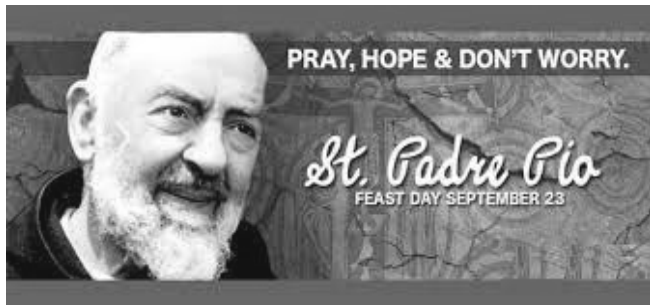

FLU AND PNEUMONIA SHOTS CLINIC – NEXT SUNDAY, SEPT. 25



Walgreen pharmacists will be at St. Isaac Jogues Church and at St. Martha Church next Sunday, Sept. 25, to administer flu and pneumonia shots. Children ages 3 yrs. and older are able to receive the flu shot. If there is a desire for the **senior flu shot** (65+ years and older) they will be provided along with the regular **flu and pneumonia shots**. Children under 18 will need a parent/guardian with them to sign permissions. Please bring your insurance card or Medicare Part B card.

Shots will be administered at St. Isaac Jogues in one of the class rooms, 8:45 –11:45 a.m. and people will enter the building during Mass times from outside door #11. **Shots will be administered at St. Martha in the Café from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.** To help the pharmacists plan the number of shots to bring and which ones, **you are asked to sign up on the sheets at the doors of the churches today. You can also call 847-966-1180 to be put on the list.** Please know that you can still come next Sunday, even if you don't sign up, but they'd like to be as prepared as possible so please try to respond today.

Volunteers to help with the registration process and light refreshments are sought for both churches. If you can help for an hour or more please contact Dee Stanton, 847/966-1180 or dstanton@archchicago.org this week. Let's all do our part to be our healthiest and to help keep one another safe and well!
