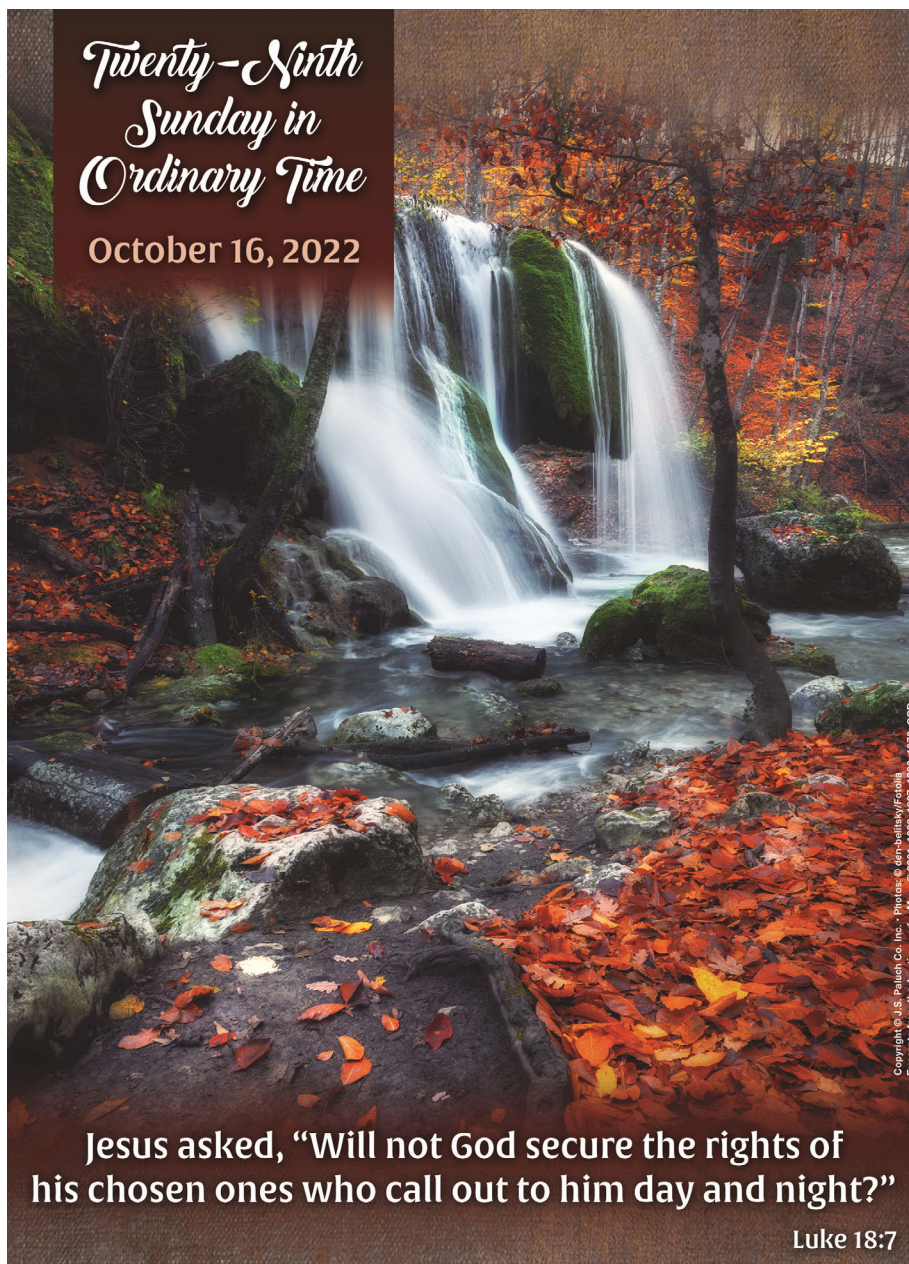

**BABY BOTTLES**

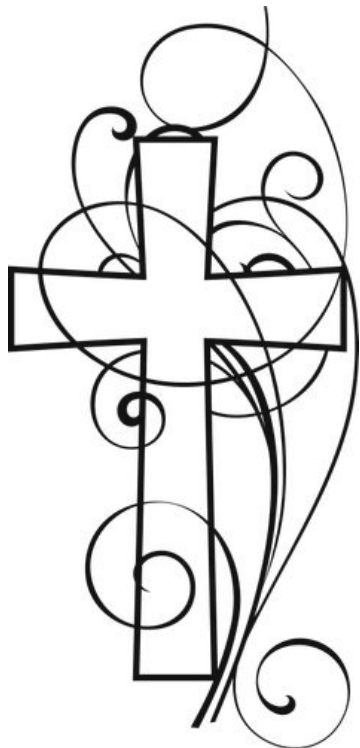

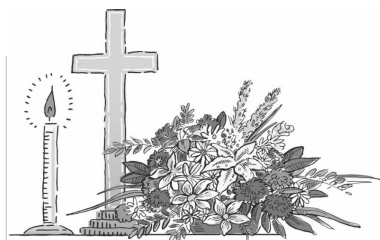

### CROP WALK

The Niles/Park Ridge CROP Walk to help end hunger is Sunday, October 16. Teams from All Saints, Our Lady of Ransom and St. John Brebeuf will gather in front of St. Isaac Jogues, one of the two starting off points, at 1 p.m. and the walk will begin at 1:15 p.m. for one hour. We plan to walk around the property and possibly a bit in the neighborhood. Walkers are encouraged to collect monetary donations from family members, friends and neighbors (and include your own) and bring them to the walk.
