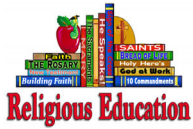

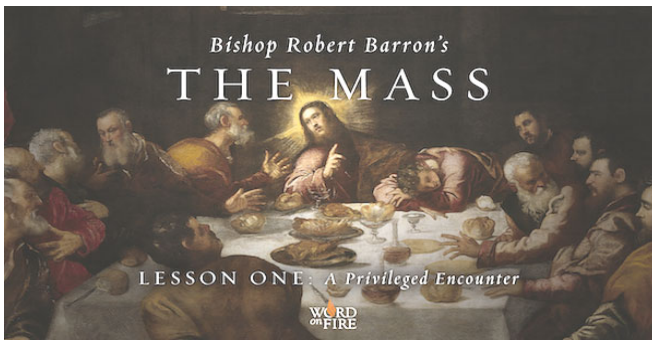


Religious Education

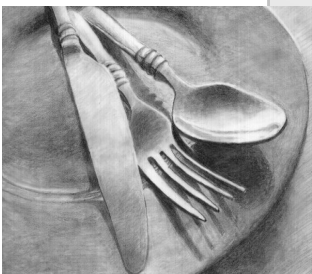

St. Isaac Jogues Fiscal Year (7/1/17 - 6/30/18) Annual Report follows. We are showing a 2 year comparison with notes to help explain the significant differences between the two years' finances. We are required by Archdiocesan policy to review our financials with our Finance Committee. We meet regularly and they are aware of the parish financial condition. We are also required by Archdiocesan policy to publish a full report by November 1st so every parishioner has an opportunity to review the report.

While the bottom line is negative, it is not as bad as it appears. Keep in mind that the expenses (\$48,229) for the roof were funded from our To Teach Who Christ Is account which is not included in the income numbers.

Some of the shortages are the result of conscious decisions & planning. All of our energies right now are focused on our "Assure Our Future" pledge campaign. We decided to limit major fundraising events until 2019. We are always looking for ways to complete necessary tasks in different ways - more efficient, less expensive where possible - with minimal impact to St. Isaac Jogues or our parishioners. Leases with most current tenants have been renewed. We continue to explore new income opportunities with people interested in renting our facilities. We believe that the campus is more visible in the community when we're busy! Many of our renters are repeat visitors who enjoy our great space, location and parking. We are continuing to work in the background with contractors and architects to find lower cost construction alternatives where possible so we can complete more projects more quickly.
