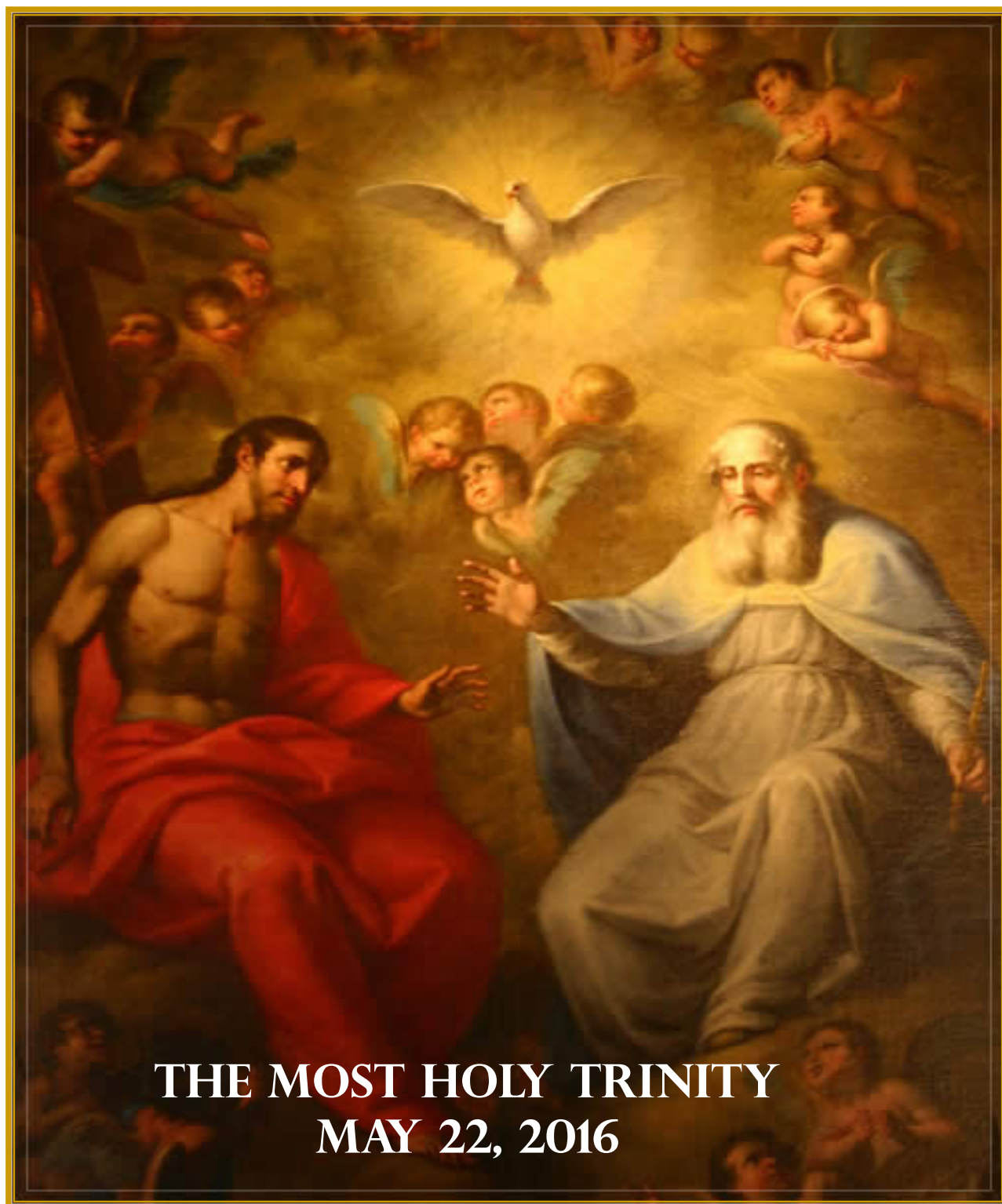

Dear Friends,

It is always a great joy to visit St. Isaac Jogues Parish. It is a warm and friendly place that is home to a great diversity of people. I look forward to being with you again in the not too distant future.

Recently, some have inquired about the change in the pastorate. Fr. Luczak will be retiring and Fr. Mario Pereira of the Pilar Fathers will become pastor on July 1<sup>st</sup>. They were concerned that this change had some deeper implications, especially with the recent announcement of an Archdiocesan wide planning process, "Renew My Church."

This change had been planned long before the "Renew My Church" process was conceived. Fr. Luczak was reaching the retirement age for priests and a new pastor would be scheduled to be assigned to St. Isaac Jogues in the normal course of events. At that time, the Pilar Fathers were sending additional members of their community to serve here in the Archdiocese. They had been very successful in their ministry at St. Timothy and work well with parish based efforts such as evangelization and parish vitality. With the great diversity of the parish and the openness of Fr. Luczak to many peoples, the Pilar Fathers seemed to be a "good fit" with St. Isaac Jogues.

It does not change things for St. Isaac Jogues. It remains part of the Archdiocese. It is still under the authority of Archbishop Cupich. It will remain part of all the activities of the Archdiocese. It is still part of fundraising efforts such as the Annual Archdiocesan Appeal. It is part of the "Renew My Church" planning process.

I do want to take this opportunity to thank Fr. Andrew Luczak for his many years of faithful service to the Archdiocese, especially for his work at St. Isaac Jogues. I also want to thank the Pilar Fathers for their generosity in coming to Chicago and serving the people of this great Archdiocese.

I look forward to installing your new pastor and let me be the first to congratulate you on the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the founding of St. Isaac Jogues. God bless all of you, especially of those who work so hard to make St. Isaac Jogues a wonderful parish.

## Corpus Christi Procession will begin at the end of the Noon Mass next Sunday, May 29<sup>th</sup>

Scripture readings, hymns and prayers will be offered in four languages in addition to English, along with Benediction. Joining us for this special celebration will be members of our sharing parish, Maternity BVM, and our neighboring church, St. Mary Knanaya Church in Morton Grove. First Communicants, the Fil-Am Group and Polish representatives will have a special part in the procession as well. Weather permitting we will process outside to four altars that will be set up around the property (one facing each direction. Part of the parking lot may be blocked off that day for set up and for the safety of all during the procession. The back road gate will be closed at 12:15 p.m.

Parking will also be available at Colonial Funeral Home. If you do not plan to stay for the procession, you may want to park over there. Once the procession begins, you will not be able to move your car from our parking lot until the procession has safely moved to the first altar. Ushers will be in the parking lot to facilitate movement. Please follow their direction. If the weather does not cooperate, we will have the procession inside with the altars set up in the Holy Family Room. Lunch will follow the procession no matter where it is held.

We are still in need of people to help with a variety of tasks -- carry the canopy over the Blessed Sacrament, carry the Eucharistic banner, clean up after the procession, serve and clean up at the lunch, and people to help provide side dishes for the lunch. 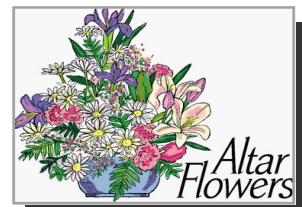
